

CHUCHUNA SCHOLARSHIP FUND PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

INTRODUCTION

The Chuchuna Scholarship Fund (CSF) was established in April 2017 under a mineral exploration agreement between Chuchuna Minerals Company and Six-Mile Mining Company (a.k.a. Quaterra Resources, Incorporated). The scholarship fund is administered by the Kijik Corporation Education Committee for the benefit of Kijik Corporation shareholders and their descendants. The establishment of this scholarship fund is intended to demonstrate the founder's recognition of their obligation to not only promote responsible and environmentally sound mineral development but also to contribute to stakeholder opportunities that allow for growth and personal development.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the CSF is to provide financial assistance to eligible applicants seeking to engage in a post-secondary education curriculum, at an accredited institution, that results in a college degree, vocational education certificate or occupational endorsement.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for CSF funding consideration, the applicant must:

- 1. Be an original shareholder of Kijik Corporation or descendent of an original shareholder.
- 2. Be accepted or enrolled in an accredited college, university or technical vocational school. If you are not yet accepted, you must submit a letter from the school indicating your application is pending.
- 3. Be attending or planning to attend school on a full-time basis. If full-time status is not maintained throughout the academic year or term, funding eligibility will be terminated. Full-time status is defined as:

a. Undergraduate Student: Enrolled in a minimum of 12 creditsb. Graduate Student: Enrolled in a minimum of 9 credits

4. Be, at a minimum, a 2.00 GPA student, if already enrolled as a student, or performing at a satisfactory level, according to the training instructor, in whatever vocational training program student is enrolled.

DEADLINES

Undergraduate School Applicants – A completed application must be received by the Kijik Corporation office by no later than the last working day of May of any given year.

ESSAYS

First-time undergraduate school applicants are required to submit an essay to the Kijik Education Committee that sets forth the applicants:

- 1. Educational goals
- 2. Professional goals
- 3. Description of community or volunteer service or other relevant extra-curricular activity
- 4. Background information or any other information the applicant elects to submit that may be helpful for the Education Committee to better understand the applicant.

Returning students should update their original essay each academic year and incorporate recent achievements, current activities and growth experiences.

Graduate students are required to submit, in addition to the essay, two professional letters of recommendation. Letters from immediate family members will not be accepted and must be recent (within the past 30 days) and submitted by an individual knowledgeable of applicant's educational and professional development or academic success.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The following represents the maximum funding amount available under the respective category:

- 1. Undergrad./Associate or Bachelors \$2,500 (Per academic year or \$1250/semester)
- 2. Graduate/Masters or Doctorate \$4,000 (Per academic year or \$2000/semester)

APPLICATION PROCESS

Completed applications, with all required supporting documents, must be submitted to the Kijik Corporation office by the established deadline noted above. Incomplete applications will be returned to the applicant. Any changes to the information contained on the application, while it is pending, must be reported to Kijik Corporation. Only CSF application form is accepted.

FUNDING

Funds awarded under the CSF will be disbursed directly to the registrar or financial aid office of applicants selected college, university or training institute for the payment of tuition, fees, room & board and books. Funds will not be disbursed directly to the applicant.



CHUCHUNA SCHOLARSHIP FUND APPLICATION

Note: The deadline for submitting your application for Chuchuna Scholarship Fund (CSF) consideration is the last working day in May. Your completed applications must be received by the Kijik Corporation office (not postmarked) no later than the close of business of May.

A. WHO MAY APPLY

- 1. Shareholders of Kijik and descendants of shareholders.
- 2. Students currently accepted to or enrolled in nationally or regionally accredited institutions of higher education or vocational schools.
- **3.** Recipients of CSF scholarships in previous years may reapply.
- **4.** Applicants who already hold a degree or have vocational training may apply, however, Chuchuna will give priority consideration to individuals who are seeking their first degree or who have no previous vocational training.

B. APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- **1.** Each scholarship applicant must submit a completed application to be considered for a scholarship. A completed application includes the following items:
 - a. Scholarship Application
 - **b.** Essay
 - c. Current Resume
 - **d.** Most recent official high school or college transcript
 - **e.** Two Letters of recommendation (if graduate applicant)
 - **f.** A copy of an acceptance letter from school in which you plan to attend (if new applicant)
- **2.** It is highly recommended that you send your application to the Kijik Corporation Office "certified/return receipt" via US Postal Service and keep a copy for your records.

APPLICATIONS THAT ARE SENT VIA FAX MACHINE OR EMAIL ARE NOT ACCEPTED.

C. **DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS**

The scholarship funds will be disbursed to the recipient's school and may be used for registration, tuition, fees, books, room and board.

D. SUCCESSFUL APPLICANT RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- **2.** If the student fails to attend school the semester, quarter or term, the scholarship for that term is forfeited.

E. SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

The following represents the maximum funding amount available under the respective category:

- 1. Undergrad./Associate or Bachelors \$2,500 (Per academic year or \$1250/semester)
- **2.** Graduate/Masters or Doctorate \$4,000 (Per academic year or \$2000/semester)

Chuchuna Scholarship Application Tips & Suggestions

- 1. Present a neat and complete scholarship application. Do not leave any portion of the application blank. Remember, your application represents you to the Education Committee!!
- **2.** Submit your application well in advance of the deadline date. Only COMPLETE applications will be considered. It is your responsibility to make sure your application packet is complete. If you mail your application, send it "certified/return receipt".
- **3.** Remember your essay and resume are very important!! This is your opportunity to personalize your application and convince the committee to select you as a scholarship recipient. The committee will be looking for applicants who have strong career goals and the desire to succeed in their chosen field of study.

Include a summary of the following activities in your resume:

- a) How you became interested in the field of study
- b) Special circumstances that you want the Education Committee to know
- c) In School Activities (organization membership, offices held, etc.)
- d) Out of School Activities (organization membership, offices held, etc.)
- e) Community Service Activities
- f) Honors and Awards
- 4. Give the people that you ask to write your letters of recommendation the appropriate information about yourself if they don't already have it: Field of study, background, GPA, etc. Give them plenty of advance time to write the letters and make copies yourself so you can use them for more than one application, if necessary. Please note that your letters of recommendation must be current and dated within 30 days.

Other Suggestions

- 1. Apply for scholarships from the college, university or technical school that you plan to attend.
- 2. Research other scholarships available through your local schools, Native organizations, village corporations, tribal councils and businesses in your area.
- 3. Check out scholarships available via "searches" on the internet
- 4. You can research general scholarships or those offered in your field of study/interest.

CHUCHUNA SCHOLARSHIP FUND GOVERNANCE & FUND MANAGEMENT POLICIES

1. CONFLICT OF INTEREST

No Kijik Corporation Education Committee member will be allowed to participate in the review, discussion, or voting on the application of an immediate family member seeking scholarship funding consideration.

2. DIRECTOR APPLICANTS

Any Kijik Corporation director seeking scholarship funding consideration will submit their application to the Kijik Chairman and the application will then be reviewed by the full Kijik Board of Directors, as opposed to the Education Committee, and subject to all the same rules and standards of review as other applicants.

3. CSF BANK ACCOUNT

Kijik Corporation will establish a separate checking account, entitled *Chuchuna Scholarship Fund Account*, for the purpose of transacting the scholarship disbursements authorized by the Kijik Education Committee.

4. TAXES

Kijik Corporation shall be solely responsible for any taxes that may result from the payment of the scholarship fund by Six Mile Mining Company to Kijik Corporation.

5. SHORT-TERM TRAINING

Scholarship funding will not be authorized for short-term (<2 weeks) training opportunities, i.e. HAZMAT, youth conferences, workshops, seminars etc. and including seminars offering 1 CEU.

6. SCHOLARSHIP DISBURSEMENTS

Scholarship funds will not be disbursed to the applicant.
